

# Flag Placement Procedure

## Colfax Cemetery Veterans Graves

Get a count of flags needed for each section from the section lists at the bottom of [www.findagrave.com/cgi-bin/fg.cgi?page=vcList&contribId=47744234](http://www.findagrave.com/cgi-bin/fg.cgi?page=vcList&contribId=47744234); note that the counts include the special situations listed below.

1. Set the special situation flags first (see [www.colfaxveterans.org/cemetery-maps.html](http://www.colfaxveterans.org/cemetery-maps.html) for maps and lists)
  - Purple Heart recipients (one person)
  - POWs (one person)
  - Pre-WWI Veterans (one person)
  - Veterans without VA markers (2 or 3 people)
2. Then place the bulk of the flags. Assign specific sections to specific people. Give each of these people the list of non-veterans (below) as some graves appear to be veterans but aren't.
3. Have different people double-check that no one was overlooked and that non-veterans and not flagged.

### Non-Veterans

- Calkins, C. G. (listed as the husband of Caroline Cathcart on her headstone)  
He is a veteran but is not buried in the Colfax Cemetery.
- Knuckles, Jason Britt
- Schillinger, Lewis
- Randall, Zona
- Randall, G. Walter
